To County Attorneys, Sheriffs and Clerks

I wish to call your particular attention to the new provision in the Game Law as enacted by the regular session of the Legislature, relating to the open season on prairie chickens. The old law provided an open season from September 15th to November 15th. The new law provides this open season to be from October 15th to November 15th inclusive. The open season for any other game birds in unchanged, being the same as provided by the Session Laws of 1917.

The force of regular game wardens will be increased by a number of Federal Game Wardens as well as the law enforcement officers of this State and all of the various inspectors in the Department of Agriculture, Every effort will be made to prosecute offenders who violate provisions of this law before the open season: bigios. !"
