

Professor Howard Gramlich, head of the Animal Husbandry department was then introduced and talked to the members of the calf club on fitting and showing their calves. He gave a demonstration, using Mr. Steward's show calves. He talked to the Live Stock Breeders on the value of Organization, and gave a judging demonstration, using Clarence Johnston's aged bull and his junior bull calf, and Mr. Steward's senior bull calves and aged cow. It was a great treat to have Professor Gramlich with us on this occasion. He left the Iowa State Fair Tuesday evening, rode all night, and came down from Hastings in a car in order to be with us on schedule time.
