**BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
MAKES LEVIES FOR YEAR**

Red Cloud, Nebr.

August 19, 1920.

The Webster County Board of Equalization met as per the call of the Clerk at 10 o'clock a. m. with all members present except Herrick.

A certificate was read from the State Board of Equalization certifying that the State Levy was 10.39 mills on the dollar on the assessed value of all Real and Personal property in Webster county for the year 1920. The assessed value of said Webster county being \$6,316,695.

The State Board of Equalization also notified the Webster County Board of Equalization that an equalizing between the counties of the state they had reduced all land and improvements thereon, by ten per cent said decrease not to apply to lots in towns and villages. County Clerk instructed to correct the assessment rolls in accordance with above notice.

On motion the following levy was made for Webster county for the year 1920:

General Fund 5.61 mills on the Dollar.

Road Fund 4 mills on the Dollar.

Bridge Fund 4 mills on the Dollar and whereas, an emergency exists an additional levy of One (1) mill on the dollar is hereby levied as an Emergency Bridge Fund.

Total County Levy to be 14.61 mills on the dollar on the assessed value of all Real and Personal property in Webster county, Nebraska, for the year 1920. Motion carried.

On motion the following levies were made on the assessed value of all Real and Personal property for School and Bond purposes for the various School Districts of Webster county for the year 1920.
