Providing for the regulation, management and control of the Electric Light and Power of electric current, protecting the system from injuries, prescribing the manner of supplying current for lighting and power purprovisions of this ordinance and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances of the City of Red Cloud conflicting with any of the provisions of this ordinance.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Red Cloud, Nebraska:

Section 1. The Light Commissioner of the City of Red Cloud shall have the general conpower system and shall have the immediate by either party to discontinue. charge and control of all the property, appliances, machinery, materials and supplies provided for said system, and shall perform the duties required of him by the laws of this state and the ordinances of this city, in relation to said system, and such orders of the Mayor and Council pertaining thereto as may be made from time to time
