It seems likely that Austrian pine, successfully used in Europe under similar conditions, will prove valuable here, It is especially useful in its ability to improve the quality of the soil by the addition of large quantities of humus. Scotch and Norway pines are also being tested. Jack pine has already proven successful. In each test the results will be judged not on a mere theoretical basis, but by the Ancient Rome and Olympia to fade actual percentage of trees surviving each experimental plot the trees have been given an equal chance for success
