Champion Carrier Pigeons.

B. A. Fogg of Hants Mill, Garland, is the possessor of some rare carrier pigeons. He has one pair of which the father and mother have a record of flying from Minneapolis, Minn., to Boston in 50 hours. For the last thousand miles of their flight they flew against a northeast storm, arriving with ice and snow frozen to their plumage. This pair had never flown west of Buffalo before. They partook of no food on their trip. Mr. Fogg also has a pair of English carriers, the father and mother having a record of flying over 3,000 miles. These birds are the same breed as those that flew from the harbor of Ales, the Norwegian explorer, who perished in his attempt to reach the North Pole. He has also 12 homers that he has flown from points in Maine. One pair has a record of flying from the January 6th records to Portland, 75 miles, in 28 minutes, and from Scarborough, 40 miles, in 50 hours, etc.—Kennebec Journal.
