### School Board Meets.

Red Cloud, Neb., Sept. 8, 1909.  
Board met in regular session. Minutes read and approved. Nelson, School Superintendent, Bostwick and Fulton.  
Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.  
August 25th report of building committee for the school district of Red Cloud approved. Bohrer has made the following report on the plans and specifications of the Lincoln school now in process of construction to wit:  
All buildings on second story to be tiled with slip impervious material. Installation at a cost of \$17, one hundred sixty dollars extra. A glass and wood vestibule partition to be installed at a cost of \$10, one hundred forty six dollars extra. North and south entrance door to be equipped with YouDuprin patent fire latch and door checks in place of common locks at a cost of \$81.00, eighty one and sixty hundredths dollars extra. On motion warrant was ordered drawn on General Fund in favor of F. W. Studebaker for payment of labor and material at Washington school. Carried.

### A Kilowatt and What It Will Do.

Electricity is measured by the kilowatt hour. The rates for buying current from the electric light plant for power, light or heat or for charging the electric runabout, are always so much for each kilowatt hour of electricity consumed. This is just so much Greek to the average man and if you tell him a kilowatt is one and one-third horse-power he will only get a faint idea of what it is all about.  
To explain the term needs, first, a clear definition, and then a comparison. Every one will understand that a certain amount of force must be used to drive electric current through a circuit. This force is measured by volts; thus we have 110 volt currents and 220 volt currents, the one expressing just twice the force of the other, but the quantity of current passing through a circuit depends upon the volts and the resistance, and so the quantity of electricity consumed by a circuit will vary.  
Now, Mr. Bohrer, the president of the Board, has been very kind to give me a few minutes to explain to you what a kilowatt hour is, and what it will do. A kilowatt hour is the amount of electricity consumed by a circuit in which the current is one ampere and the voltage is one thousand volts, for one hour. 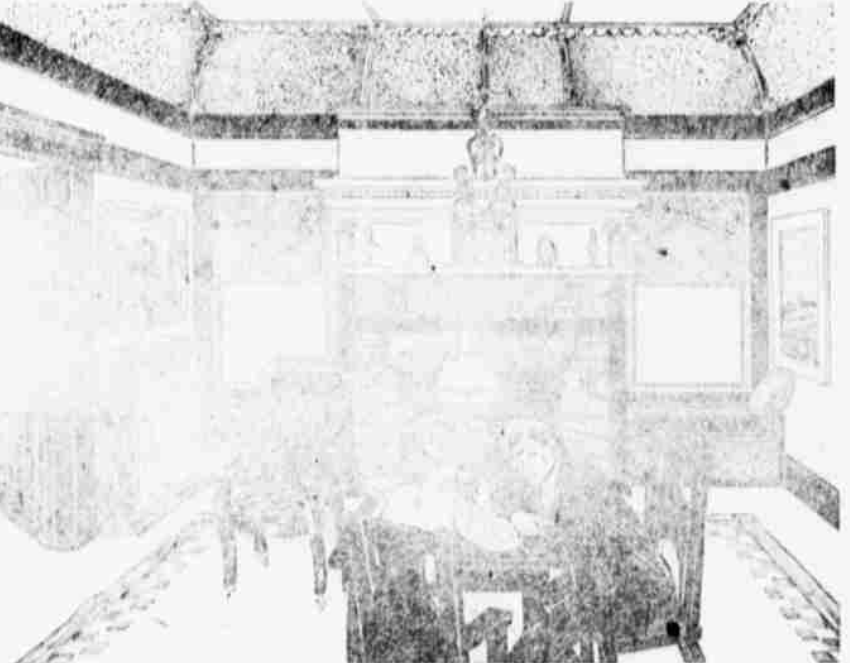
