WASHINGTON LETTER

It is expected that the Government will soon have real accurate data relative to the tariff question. It has long been in need of such data. The conflicting testimony of trusts and individuals interested in high protective tariff has clouded the issue and made an intelligent tariff revision next to impossible. When the Aldrich-Payne revision was under consideration by the late special session of Congress legislators were groping in the dark and the necessary information bearing on the cost of production here and abroad was inaccessible. There was much opposition to a special tariff commission and this opposition will, doubtless, be continued and no matter what the findings of the tariff commission may be there will be special advocates of the trusts on the floors of the House and of the Senate who will criticize and ingeniously disprove the figures of any tariff commission. Figures, it is said, will not lie but liars will figure. It will be remembered that the Payne law did not provide for the creation of a tariff commission without limitation but under the authority granted the President in the maximum and minimum section of the law he has created a tariff board which is equivalent to a tariff commission. This board consists of men well versed in tariff, commercial and industrial questions, and they will be engaged in the task of gathering data bearing on trade discriminations against this country. When their work in this respect is completed the President will have them investigate every phase of the tariff question. He made his intention clear in a conference with them last Tuesday. 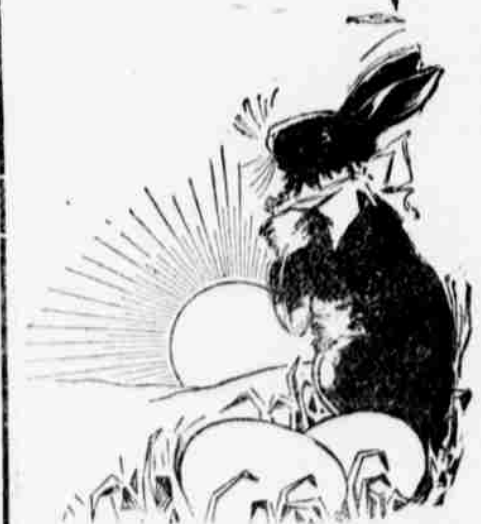
