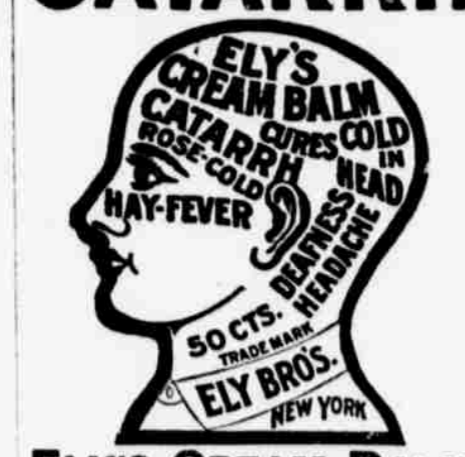
**Widow's Pension.**

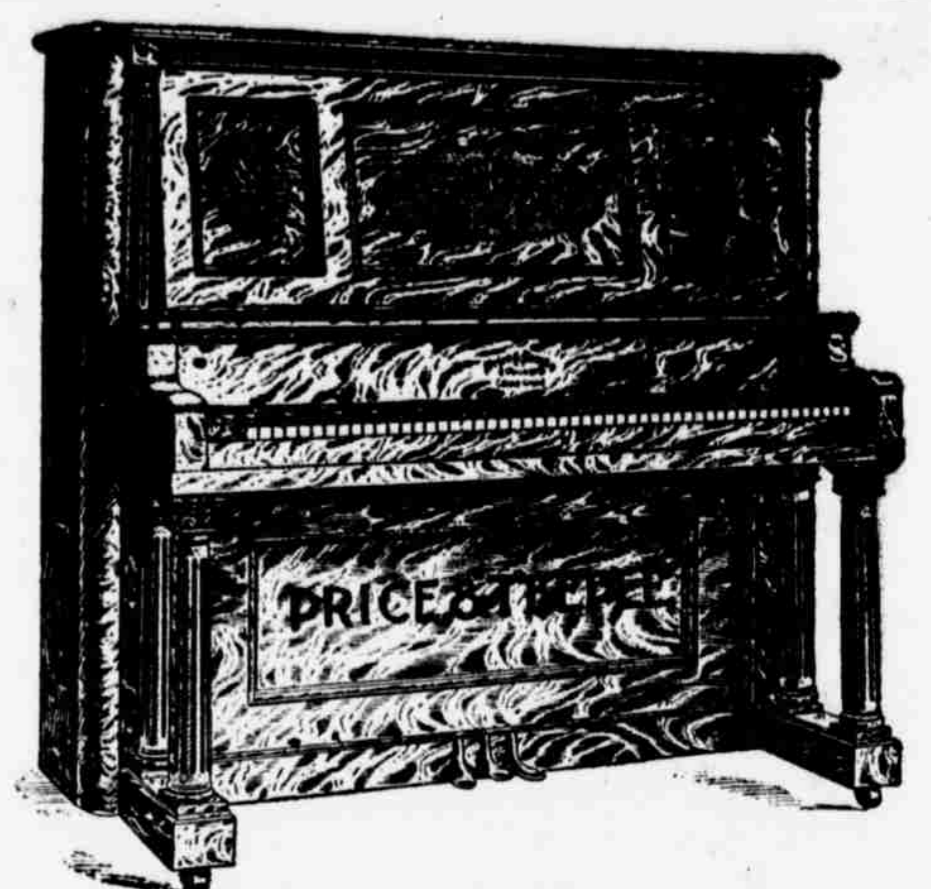
