

The total area of the United States is about 1,911,000,000 acres. Of this about 841,000,000, or less than one half, was in farms in 1900. Less than one half of these farms were improved. > The 841,000,000 acres of agricultural land were in 1900 divided into 5,700,000 farms, an increase of 1,700,000, or more than 40 per cent. over the number of farms in 1880, a rate of growth nearly double that of the population. Still it should be here noted again that the rate of the increase of the total population is much more rapid than the rate of increase in rural population That is to say, that though the number of people to be fed by the products of agriculture is increasing at a rapid rate and the reduction of the farms on which these products are raised is proceeding even more rapidly, the number of people actually carrying on aggiculture is relatively less.

> These figures, while not at all exhaustive, are conclusive with respect to one thing: Farmers of the United to produce more per acre from their land This they have been accomplishing for many years and it may be ventured that if the average production per acre were today what it was 25 years ago there would be a shortage of agriculture products for home consumption.-American Lumberman.


