**Ordinance No. 89**

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE CHICAGO, BURLINGTON & QUINCY RAILROAD COMPANY, A CORPORATION, THE RIGHT TO LAY AND MAINTAIN UNDERNEATH THE SURFACE OF THE GROUND A LINE OF WATER PIPE EIGHT (8) INCHES IN DIAMETER, IN A PORTION OF ELM STREET, THIRD AVENUE, WEBSTER STREET, DIVISION STREET AND CEDAR STREET, IN THE CITY OF RED CLOUD, WEBSTER COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Red Cloud, Webster County, Nebraska:

Section 1. That there is hereby granted to the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company the right to lay and maintain, at a depth of four (4) feet underneath the surface of the ground, a line of water pipe eight (8) inches in diameter in the following streets in the City of Red Cloud, Nebraska, to-wit: in that part of Elm Street extending from the north line of the southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of section thirty-six (36), township two (2) north, range eleven (11) west, which is the north line of the corporate limits of the City of Red Cloud, southerly to Third Avenue, and westerly in said Third Avenue to Webster Street, and southerly in said Webster Street to Division Street, and westerly in said Division Street to Cedar Street, and southerly in said Cedar Street to the right of way and grounds of the said Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company.

Section 2. The agents and employees of said Railroad Company shall have the right to enter upon the above described streets and excavate a trench in which to lay said line of water pipe, and said Railroad Company, shall at its own expense fill up all trenches or excavations made, after said pipe line is laid therein, in a workman-like manner and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer of said City of Red Cloud.

Section 3. The Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company hereby agrees to save and hold harmless the City of Red Cloud in any claim of damage on account of laying and maintaining the above described pipe line under the grant herein made.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law. Passed and approved this 9th day of May A. D. 1912.

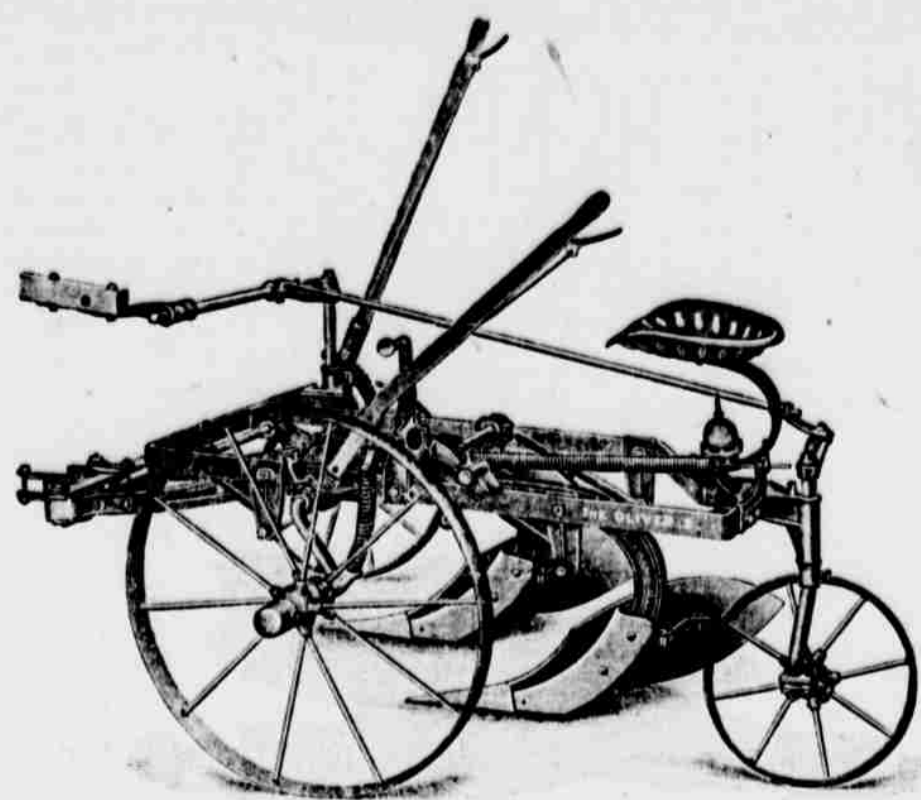
