MONEY AND STOCKS.

New York, June 11.—Money closed easy at 246.63 per cent. Exchanges steady at \$4 84 46 to \$4 86.

Governments firm; currency 6 1/2; 131 bid; 4's comp., 118 bid; 4 1/2's comp., 115 bid; Pacific railroad bonds closed as follows: Union firsts, 119 1/2; land grants, 138 to 140; sinking funds, 130 to 133; Centrals, 117 to 118.

Stock market this morning was active and buoyant, and prices advanced 4 to 34 per cent in the general list, while Louisville, New Albany & Chicago sold up 15 per cent, and afterwards reacted 2 per cent.

The largest transactions were in trunks, Shares of Western Pacific, Western Union, Texas Pacific, and Union Pacific continued strong throughout the morning and closed with the highest prices of the day. The current advance from the point ranged from 5 to 5 per cent.

The largest stocks today were the Union Pacific, Western Union, Memphis and Charleston, Ohio & Mississippi, Wabash, Northern Pacific, Northwest, Louisville & Nashville, Milwaukee, Lake Shore & Western, Bowdon Air Line, New Albany & Chicago and Marietta & Cincinnati.

Russell Sage says the Western Union is now earning at the rate of \$14,000,000 gross a month. He intimates that the saving in operating expenses is increasing so rapidly that the stockholders will be astonished at the economy accomplished in one department alone. Outside of disbursements for salaries, the reduction will amount to at least \$1,000,000.

THE NATIONAL TREASURY.

Washington, June 11.—Following is the amount of national bank circulation outstanding at the close of business at the treasury, June 10: Notes of Federal Reserve banks, \$1,000,000; currency notes, \$1,000,225; currency notes, \$33,577,772; total, \$34,671,997. United States bonds held by the treasurer to secure national bank deposits, \$1,000,000; gold, \$500,000; as follows: Currency notes, \$3,563,000; six per cents, \$575,000; five per cents, \$92,250; four and one-half per cents, \$83,466,550; three and one-half per cents, \$83,466,700; U. S. bonds deposited to security circulation during the week, \$82,893,500; half per cents, \$56,500; three-and-one-half per cents, \$56,500; four-and-one-half per cents, \$8,897,000; four per cents, \$6,480,600.

MONEY IN CHICAGO.

OMAHA Wholesale Market.

Saturday Evening, June 11, 1881.

Saturday's markets showed a firm feeling in trade with a general tendency towards higher prices. The week's business was reported as considerably heavier than for the week previous with country collections easier and a steady demand for all articles. Groceries were firm, and wholesalers reported the market generally active, and firms at last quotations. The grain market was feverish. Wheat No. 2, cash, advanced 3 cents over Friday's price; No. 3 jumping forward 3 1/2 cents. Barley was quoted at an advance of 10 cents for No. 2, and 8 cents for No. 3, dealers finding it difficult to fill the demand for local brewing. Rye was dull and small demand, prices being quoted at 7 cents lower than Friday's closing quotations.

The live stock market was dull. A slight decline was noticed in the prices of cattle. Hogs declined a few cents. Sheep dropped 15 cents. There is no change to note in the provision or produce markets, prices being held firm at last quotations with good demand for first class articles. Paints and oils, general hardware, hives, leather and wool remain as at last advices.
