WASHINGTON TERRITORY

A Visit to the Shores of Puget's Sound.

Olympia, the capital of Washington territory, is a beautiful city, built upon a peninsula jutting down into Puget Sound from the center of an amphitheater of hills.

Washington Territory lies between the forty-sixth and forty-ninth parallels of north latitude, the Pacific ocean and the western boundary of Idaho.

The eastern section contains 20,000,000 acres of grain, prairie, sage, bunch grass and grazing land.

Washing Washington, known as the "Puget Sound Basin," lies west of the Cascade Mountains.

There is much unoccupied land in Washington Territory, and the country is rapidly being settled.
