There are 382 of these marks between the Lake of the Woods and the base of the Rocky Mountains. This portion of the boundary which lies east and west of the Red River valley is marked by iron pillars at seven mile intervals. The British placed one every two miles, and the United States one between each British post.

The inscriptions begin about 4 feet 6 inches above the base, and read upward. The interior of the hollow posts are filled with well seasoned cedar posts, sawed in a blanket, and spiked through spike holes cast in the pillars for the purpose.
