MONEY AND STOCKS.

NEW YORK, June 14.

The stock market opened active and generally higher, the advance ranging from 1 to 15 per cent, led by Western Union telegraph. Missouri Pacific, Union Pacific, Central Pacific, St. Paul, Michigan Central and Northwestern, Lake Shore declined 1 to 2 per cent; Peoria Pacific, 2 per cent; and Lakes, 1 per cent; Peoria Pacific, 2 per cent; LaSalle, 1 per cent; and New York Pacific preferred, 1 per cent. The Texas Pacific and Missouri, Kansas & Texas were active and buoyant; Missouri Pacific and Iron Mountain likewise strong and higher.

It was reported on the street that afternoon that the market in favor of the Western Union will be repeated in the transaction suits that have been brought by Williams & Hatch. The Western Union pool are now buying new stock in anticipation of favorable verdicts and large earnings of the company, which are showing about 11 per cent on the capital stock of \$80,000,000.

The stock market during the last hour's business was quiet and feverish.

Vanderbilts are steady; Grangers weak; coal shares heavy; Southwestern declined 16 to 2 per cent from the highest, and the general tendency was downward.

Bank stocks closed as follows: Union firsts, 119 1/2; 120; 121; secondaries, 118; sinking funds, 130; Central Pacific, 117 to 118.

At the close the market became strong, and prices advanced, the closing quotations being generally from 2 to 12 per cent higher than yesterday.
