BIG GAMES ON THE SERVA.
Sovereigns Tossed and Cards Played for Heavy Stakes.

A Story Brought Out by the Trouble Between Mr. Rice and Mr. Solomon—Mr. Goldstein's Settlement by an American.

The arrest of Henry J. Rice, Jim Mace's manager, on a charge of swindling Robert Solomon, a fellow passenger on the Serva, cost nearly \$3,000 at the Market yesterday of some remarkable gambling operations on the steamer during the voyage from Liverpool.

The passengers complained on landing that Rice, Solomon, and a man named Barnes, who had been on the passenger list as "Mr. Goldstein," introduced gambling games almost immediately after the vessel left Liverpool, and maintained the play almost constantly day and night in the smoking room. About twenty other passengers joined in the play. They were stopped at night only by the closing of the smoking room at an hour before midnight. Word went about among the passengers after a time that the games were not entirely square, but it was not until after the pockets of the twenty had been lightened of several thousand dollars that this suspicion began to gain ground.

The gambling was first begun by matching sovereigns for small stakes. The wagers rapidly increased in amount until the gamblers got to flipping silver for as much as \$50 at a time. Then, it is said, the twenty found it almost impossible to match the coins thrown by the others. When the coin flipping became so notorious cards were introduced with the same result of losses to the twenty. After a time the twenty dropped out of the games, and left Rice, Solomon and Barnes playing.

As the vessel neared Quarantine a young passenger who came from India and had been betting that Barnes or Goldstein could not do a certain trick that several of the passengers said they knew was an old trick, desired merely to cheat the unwary. Among the knowing ones was a young American, who had just returned from the Oxford university. He told the young man from India that he had been floored, and said he would get his money back for him. Twenty others instantly volunteered to assist in this undertaking. They waited until 11:30 o'clock on Sunday, and went in a body to Goldstein's room and stood outside while the young American went in. Goldstein was asleep, but the visitor shook him until he was awake and cried: "If you don't give that young man his money back I will chuck you overboard. There are twenty passengers waiting outside to help me."

Goldstein took the money from his pocket, handed it over, and his unwelcome visitor went to the young man from India and delivered it to him. Then he went back with his comrades to Goldstein's room, dragged him out of his bunk, and, as one of the passengers said, "mopped the deck with him." It had been raining heavily, and Goldstein got the full benefit of the dirty weather. The proceeding made such an uproar on deck that officers came running up to discover the cause. The officers said that this incident gave them the first hint that reprehensible work had been going on on board. The incident of Rice's arrest served only to increase the indignation of the passengers. They ascended at Solomon as he ran down after Rice as if rather leaving the vessel, and rather than return for him when he came back yesterday afternoon to get the luggage he had left behind.

Rice was taken before Justice Patterson yesterday by Police Captain McDonnell of the Police street station. The justice said he had no objection in the matter, as the offense occurred on the high seas. Capt. McDonnell suggested that a complaint might be made by trick and device into the country. Lawyer Staecom, who represented Rice, said his client was willing to return the money he had won from Solomon. The justice told Capt. McDonnell to go into the examination room and endeavor to effect a settlement. Rice said he would give Solomon \$2,750 if Solomon paid the lawyer's fee. Mr. Staecom said that his fee would be \$50. Solomon said that he had lost altogether \$2,300, but would be satisfied with \$2,750. This was given to him by Capt. McDonnell, custodian of the funds. The lawyer received his fee.

Solomon begged Capt. McDonnell to accompany him to the Serva to get his baggage. He said he feared to go alone. The instant he got to the top of the gangplank he was surrounded by passengers, who asked him if he had got his money back. His affirmative reply greatly incensed some of them. "Well," cried one, "if I had won your money I would have swum ashore at Quarantine before I would allow you to get it back. You lost it at your own game."

Then a dozen passengers told Capt. McDonnell that Solomon had gambled all the time, and that he and Rice and Barnes had won a great deal of money from the other passengers. One man, they said, lost \$1,500; two Englishmen, brothers, lost \$500 each; another passenger came ashore penniless; another lost all his money and rattled his watch at five shillings a chance to get more money with which to gamble. He played again, and won back all his money and enough to get back his watch.

The captain of the steamer said that Solomon lost his money in matching with Rice and Barnes. The chief officer of the Serva said last night that he could not remember any names of passengers who had lost. They played a game of cards he did not understand. Somebody told him the game was poker, but he did not know positively. The officers very rarely knew what was going on in the smoking room, which was part of their duty to mind their own business, and they did it.

The officer in charge of the signal station at Sergeant's Knoll, near Manitowish, Michigan, explained to us the method of the signal service.
