Tables within the great reception room just opposite the ferry slip were covered with these hundreds of happy contributions. Later decorative flags were borrowed from the neighboring signal office and from the chief wharfinger, and yards upon yards of bunting in the national colors were gath-

ered from somewhere else until the high walls and the sides of the refreshment tables became bright with effective and appropriate drapery. Fruit and flowers distributed liberally over long stretches of tables, forming a hollow square with big tankards of steaming coffee and piles of sandwiches within, made a tempting display presided over by a bevy of well-dressed women in dainty aprons.
