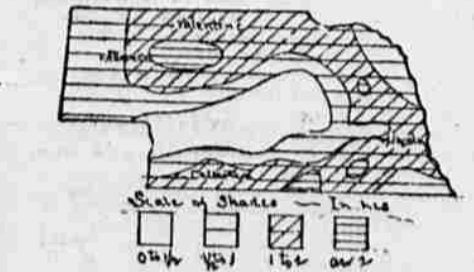

Week Lacks Some in Sunshine, with an Excess in Rainfall. VERY FAVORABLE FOR SMALL GRAIN. Rye in Bloom and Wheat Heading, Both Being a Very Heavy Stand--Grass Grows Rank and Corn Suffers Some.



The last week has been warm and wet, with less than the normal amount of sunshine. The average daily temperature excess ranged from 4 degrees in the southeastern portion to 2 degrees in the western.
