Settlement of Cash Wheat Pool Causes a Sharp Rally at the Close.

JULY AND SEPTEMBER MAKE ADVANCES

Corn Breaks and Closes Lower with Oats Following; White Provision Lines Generally Show Declines.

CHICAGO, June 21.—Confirmation of the reported settlement of the cash wheat pool caused a sharp rally near the finish in the wheat pit today. July closed with an advance of 34¢4½c and September 14¢13½c. Corn left off 1¢8c lower and oats lost 3¢c. In provisions, pork lost 1¢c and sugar 1¢c. In metals, gold was up 10¢c and silver 10¢c, while copper declined 10¢c. Lead gained 15¢c; rye straw, 4¢c; color makes the price on hay; light bales sell best; only top grades preferred.
