BISMARCK FAMILY SULLEN

Much Gossip Occasioned by Actions of Prince Herbert—German Firm's Offer to American Army.

BERLIN, Aug. 6.—The death of Prince Bismarck has, of course, engrossed public attention throughout the week.

The publications and revelations which so quickly followed the death of the prince and which have already been cabled to the Associated Press, have naturally created a sensation and deep anger in government circles.

But it is not against the emperor alone that Prince Bismarck's family acted. The reigning German princes, the peers and the nation were provoked by taking any part in the funeral.

The German newspapers this week have paid little attention to the progress of the war between Spain and the United States.

The outcome of the war is a triumph for Protestantism and further proof of the deterioration of the Latin races.

AMOUNTS AGGREGATING EIGHT MILLION DOLLARS FILED IN STATE DEPARTMENT.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 6.—The announcement that the United States government will assume liability for the claims of the insurgents against the Spanish government on account of injuries and damages sustained in the Cuban insurrection has caused the filing of a large number of claims with the States department.
