HOME PATRONAGE MOVEMENT

Commercial Club Bureau Has Sixty Factories Enrolled and is Growing.

WILL GIVE RECEPTION AND EXHIBITION

It Will Open February 15 with a Reception to Honor Merchants of Omaha and South Omaha at Commercial Club Rooms.

What is pronounced the best meeting of local manufacturers held in Omaha for years occurred at the Commercial club yesterday. It was attended by about forty representatives of local manufacturing concerns, constituting the Home Patronage Bureau of the Commercial club. At the opening arrangements were perfected for the first of a series of entertainments intended to acquaint Omaha people with the virtues of the products of Omaha factories and encourage the consumption of them here at home as a means of increasing the output, enlarging the local industrial field and increasing the wealth and population of the city.

On the reports of committees it was decided that the first entertainment shall comprise an exhibit of Omaha products in the rooms of the Commercial club lasting for ten days. It will open at 7 o'clock in the evening of February 15 with a reception by the manufacturers to the retail merchants of the city and South Omaha, at which each member of the Home Patronage Bureau will be a member of the entertainment committee. Luncheon will be served and accompanying refreshments. Owing to the limitation imposed by the size of the quarters the women will not be invited that evening. All legitimate retail dealers of Omaha and South Omaha will be invited and will be asked to advise the committee in advance of their intention to attend.

The exhibits will remain in place for ten days and the public will be invited to inspect them. Arrangements are being made with the Board of Education for the setting aside of special afternoons for the purpose.
