OMAHA-CHICAGO ROUTE

Omaha, Minneapolis & St. Paul Short Line Open for Business

Beginning Monday, January 29, from Omaha, the Illinois Central Railroad company will open new first-class line between Omaha and Council Bluffs and Chicago over its new road recently built through Council Bluffs, Denison and Rockwell City to a connection at Tara with its western line through Fort Dodge, Webster City, Waterloo, Independence, Dubuque, Preppent and Rockford.

A first-class line, because the portion between Tara and Chicago, for years in fine physical condition, has been improved at various points, bringing the whole up to the highest standard of physical condition.

A first-class line, because over it will be maintained from the first a fast, efficient and convenient train service to be rescheduled in the near future to make the running time between Omaha and Chicago the same as that of other lines between the two cities.

The through service on this new line will consist of "The Chicago Limited" and "The Chicago Express." "The Limited" will leave Omaha daily at 7:35 p. m., will be a solid wide-vestibled train, making but few stops enroute and running on fast schedule, but not least, dining cars of the very latest pattern, being chaste and decorated in light mahogany and marquetry and having the new attractive arched dome-deck, which adds so much to the ornamental features.

On the same date that this new through Omaha-Chicago line is to be opened there will also be inaugurated on the Illinois Central railroad between Omaha and Fort Dodge and over the Minneapolis & St. Louis railroad between Fort Dodge and Minneapolis and St. Paul, a new through short line (also first-class in every respect) between Omaha and Minneapolis and St. Paul.

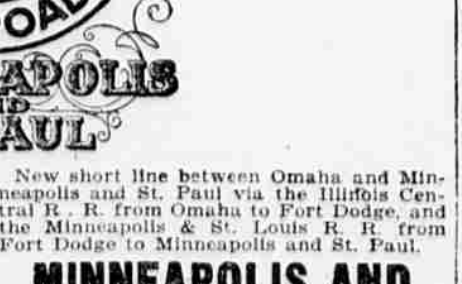

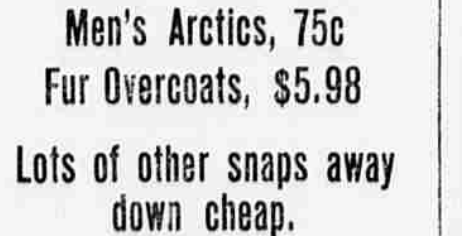
