TO VISIT THE LEGISLATURE

Company of High School Pupils Make Trip to Des Moines Today.

GO TO THE CAPITAL ON A SPECIAL TRAIN

Eleventh and Twelfth Grades, Under the Guidance of Teachers and Board Members, Will Study Process of Legislation.

The pupils of the senior and junior grades known as the eleventh and twelfth grades of the high school will go to Des Moines today to visit the legislature and thus secure a practical lesson in civil government.

The party will leave Council Bluffs at 6:30 o'clock this morning and it is expected that the party will be present at the opening of the legislature at 10 o'clock.

Reaching the capitol the party will be divided, one-half visiting the senate first and the other half the house of representatives.

At 1:30 in the afternoon Governor Shaw will tender the party a reception in his apartments and the state officers will be on hand to extend the courtesies of the building to the visiting pupils.

From 3 to 4 o'clock a ride will be taken in the cars around the city, arrangements having been made with the street railway for the special cars.

While it is conceded that the trip will form a good object lesson for the pupils there are some patrons of the high school who are opposed to it.

Historic Boundary Disputes. How Missouri Maintains Her Rights Against Other States.

The Missouri Historical society held its annual business meeting last night, reports the St. Louis Globe-Democrat.

At the conclusion of the business session the society was addressed by Judge Shepard Barclay, ex-chief justice of the supreme court of Missouri, on the subject, "Historic Controversies over the Boundaries of Missouri."

Judge Barclay told how he had first become interested in the boundary disputes which he had recently recalled in the instance of a man being killed aboard a steamer on the Mississippi river, as it lay at anchor near the Illinois shore, opposite St. Louis.

The first serious controversy Missouri had over boundaries was with Iowa. This dispute ran through several years and involved a strip of territory ten miles in width by 200 in length.
