ALLISON ON FINANCE BILL

Gives an Outline of the Measure, Replying to All Questions.

CULMIX OF A LONG DEBATE ON MONEY

Ranking Member of the Finance Committee Makes a Strong and Lucid Argument—Jones of Nevada Opposes.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 13.—The financial debate in the senate reached its climax today. Two great speeches, one in favor of the pending senate substitute measure and the other in opposition to it, were delivered, and both were listened to by senators with close attention.

The first was delivered by Allison, the ranking member of the finance committee. He had been an attentive listener to the speeches delivered on the other side of the chamber and in the course of his argument he presented his answers to the points raised against the pending senate bill.

Jones of Nevada declared that the bill was vicious and unwarranted, conferring too great power upon national banks and fastening the money to a gold currency. He discussed the question from a historical and philosophical viewpoint.

Tomorrow the senate will begin the discussion of the bill and amendments under the ten-minute rule. Allison said that his careful consideration of the senate committee had regarded it wise to deal with the pending questions in accordance with the provisions of the senate measure than in accordance with the house bill.
