STATE AUDITOR INTERVENES

Defending Policy Holders in Omaha Fire Insurance Company. CHECKS PLACED ON THE RECEIVER

He is Prevented by Injunction from Following the Method Adopted by Him—Allegations in the Petition.

State Auditor Eugene Moore has applied to the courts to be allowed to intervene in the interests of the policy holders in the case of E. L. Stone against the Omaha Fire Insurance company.

In the petition it is set forth that the policies of the Omaha Fire Insurance company now in force amount to about \$2,000,000.

It is contended that the assets of the company should be applied to reinsuring the policy holders in good companies, but it is declared to be the intention of the receiver, Earl W. Gannett, to abandon the duty of the company to the policy holders.

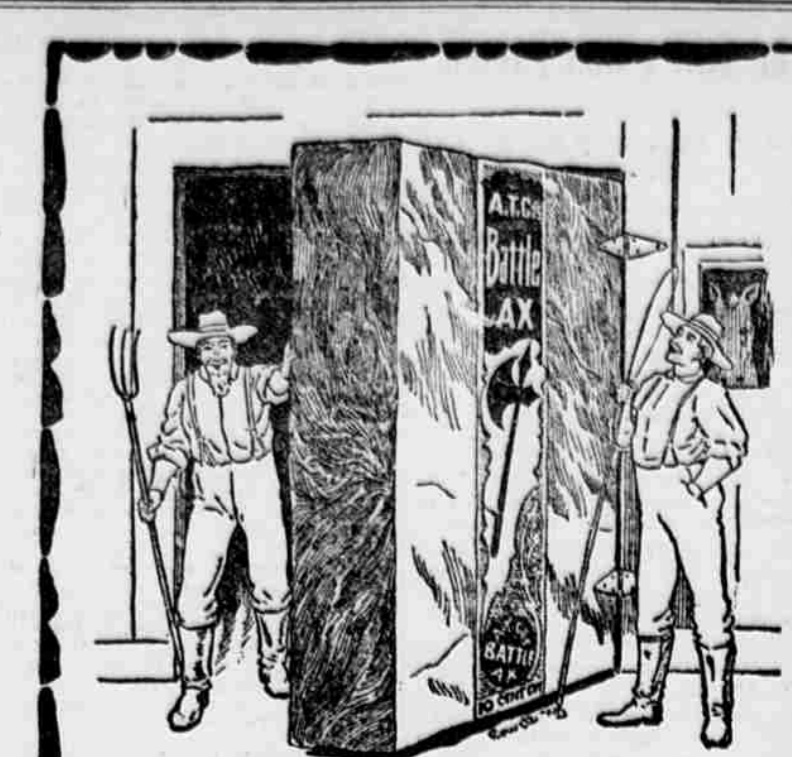
