**Seek Inclusion of  
Holt in Great  
Plains Program**

The Holt soil conservation district board of supervisors will meet today (Thursday) in the courthouse annex to conduct regular business.

In cooperation with the extension agent and unit conservationist, the board will make plans for their 1958 educational program.

On Tuesday, December 17, the entire board will go to Broken Bow to participate in an area meeting of the State Association of Soil Conservation districts.

A soil conservation district board members, FHA supervisors, county chairmen of ASC committee, extension agent and unit conservationist have sent a letter to the state conservationist requesting that Holt be included in the great plains program.

According to word received from H. G. Bobst, state conservationist, this request will be reviewed by the state program committee and forwarded to Washington for approval. Washington approvals are made quarterly and Holt county will be considered shortly after January 1, 1958.

The great plains program has been set up under public law 1021 allows cost sharing of needed conservation practices for a contract period of from three years to 10 years.

The contract covers the development of a complete conservation plan on an individual farm or ranch basis.

Sixty counties in Nebraska have been designated in the Great Plains area, but the program has been set up for only 35 of these as designated by the state program committee.

If Holt county is approved, more details on the plan will be made available as they develop locally.
