**Most of U.S. 281
Now Hardsurfaced**

A meeting of the U. S. Highway 281 association has been held at Plankinton, S. D.

It was pointed out that a relatively small amount of the transcontinental highway remains to be hardsurfaced. All of 281 in Nebraska is under contract except for eight miles north of Bartlett, in Wheeler county, and 10 miles from Spencer to the South Dakota line, in Boyd county. The Spencer-Dakota line stretch is under contract grading.

Forty-eight miles of 281 is non-hardsurfaced in South Dakota but 24 miles are under contract.

All of 281 is hardsurfaced in North Dakota, Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas. In several states it has been designated as the American Legion highway—including Nebraska where State Sen. Frank Nelson introduced the designation. Some new construction at Greeley has been completed this summer ahead of schedule.
