By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nebraska, I. Victor E. Anderson, Governor of the State of Nebraska, do hereby direct and proclaim that a general election be held in the several voting precincts throughout the State of Nebraska on the fourth day of November, 1958, during the hours designated by law, for the following purposes,

1. For the election of one United States Senator (Full

2. For the election of one member of Congress from each

of the four Congressional Districts in the State. 3. For the election of the following State officers, to-wit: Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, State Treasurer, Attorney

General and Railway Commissioner. 4. For the election of one Judge of the Nebraska Supreme Court for each of three Supreme Court Districts; Num-

bers Two, Four, and Six. 5. For the election of one member of the State Board of Education from each of two districts; Numbers Five

and Six. 6. For the election of one member of the Legislature for each of the forty-three Legislative Districts.

7. For the election of one member of the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska for each of Regent Districts; Numbers Three and Four. 8. For the election of members of the Board of Directors

of each of the Public Power and Irrigation Districts and Reclamation Districts. 9. To vote upon a Constitutional Amendment proposed by Initiative Petition which is "an Amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska requiring public corporations organized to provide electricity, or irrigation and electricity, to make future payments in lieu of taxes in the same amount and to be distributed in the same manner as required in 1957; to authorize the Legislature to impose a tax on such corporations on retail sales of electricity within municipalities in an amount equal to five per cent of gross sales less the amount actually paid in lieu of taxes; to provide the method of distribution of

tax to cities, counties, school districts and the state."

To vote upon a Constitutional Amendment proposed by

Initiative Petition which is "A Measure to amend Article III, Section 24, of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska by granting to the Legislature the authority to enact laws providing for the licensing and regulation of bingo games conducted by non-profit associations in existence for five years immediately preceding license application; Provided, bingo games, conducted by agents, or lessees, of such associations, on a percentage basis, are prohibited." 11. To vote upon seven proposals of the 1957 Legislature

III, section 7; adding new section to Article V to be known as section 27; and amending Article XI, section 6 of the Constitution of Nebraska. 12. For the election of such other officers for State and
