**O'Neill Cardinals Catch Fire Tuesday; To Play Highly Favored Ord Tonight**

**Stevens Is Hot; Hits 26**

St. Paul—St. Mary's Academy, flushed with a first bracket victory over Burwell at the District B tournament are ready to take on the Ord five tonight. (Thursday).

In a very tightly officiated game the Cardinals stepped on the gas for the 59-46 victory that placed them in a "dark horse" position in the tournament.

Highly touted Ord, with a victory string as long as your arm (15-5) and against some of the better basketball teams in the state, is favored by the multitude of sports writers by about 10 points.

In Tuesday night's tilt, Gale Stevens of O'Neill kent tournament goers' mouths wide open as he hit the nets for 26 points.

Coach Don Templemeyer told a Frontier reporter that he thought the foul shooting of the Cardinals had improved to a point where "Ord could have a very rough time." The Cardinals hit 22 free throws in the Burwell game.

"We're up against it as far as Ord is concerned," Templemeyer said. "But if we can get all five guys going in addition to some help from someone hot, we'll be alright."

Templemeyer said he looked for Ainsworth to play Raysons in the semifinals on the other side of the bracket with a slight edge for Ainsworth.

**O'Neill Reserves Ready For Tournament March 9**

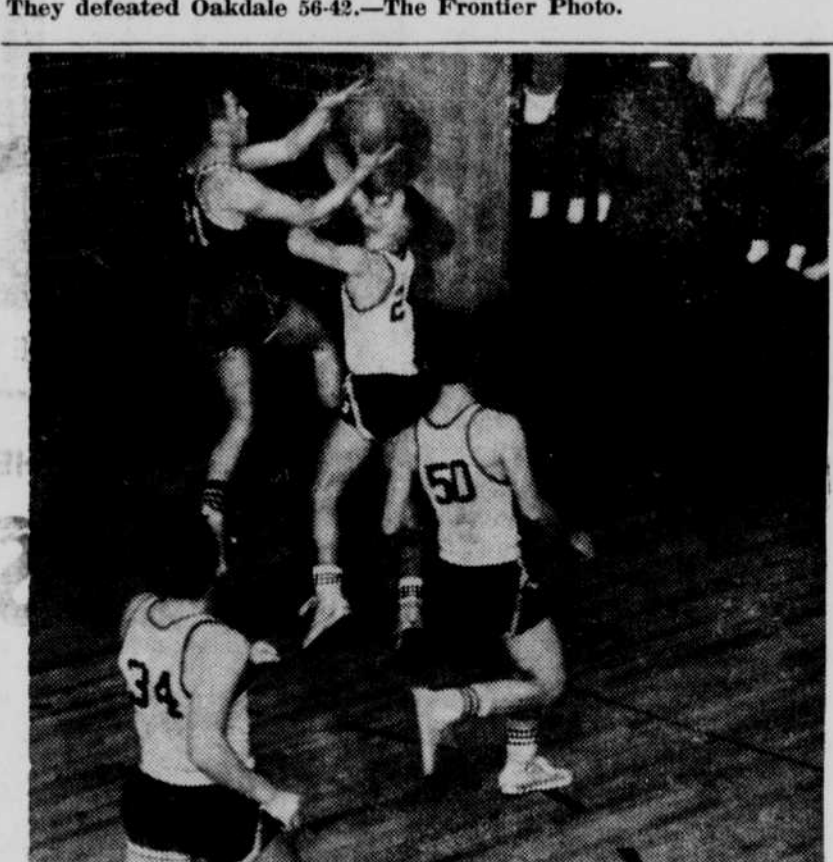
The O'Neill second team will play in the North Central Nebraska Conference reserve tournament March 9.
