Holt County Board of Supervisors met as per adjournment. All members present, except Ernst. Meeting called to order by the Chairman. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

The Finance Committee reported that the fees of the various County Offices, have been remitted to the County Treasurer, as required by law.

Motion by Landreth, seconded by Smith, that the East 50 feet of Lot 2, Block 3, of the Village of Inman, Holt County, Nebraska, be sold to Harry McGraw for the sum of \$5.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Dierking, seconded by McConnell, to adopt the following Resolution.

RESOLUTION
Creating a Joint Airport Zoning Board in accordance with Section 3-304 R.R.S. 1943.

It is hereby found and determined that:

1. The O'Neill Municipal Airport is an airport owned and controlled by the city of O'Neill, Nebraska, and is located 1/2 mile north and 1 mile west of and outside the territorial limits of such city.

2. The area of land and water extending out in all directions a distance of three miles from the adjacent boundaries of said airport constitutes an airport hazard area within the meaning of Sec. 3-301 (3) R.R.S.

Such airport hazard area, pertaining to the above mentioned airport is located entirely within the County of Holt, and entirely (partly) outside the territorial limits of the city of O'Neill, Nebr.

It is necessary that the city of O'Neill, the political subdivision owning and controlling the above named airport, and the county of Holt, the political subdivision within which the airport hazard area is located, create a Joint Airport Zoning Board in accordance with Sec. 3-304 R.R.S. 1943.

Clarence Ernst and Larry D. Schaffer, residents of the County, are hereby appointed as members of such Joint Airport Zoning Board, to represent the County of Holt, thereon.

The foregoing Resolution having been fully and distinctly read aloud, the motion for its adoption was seconded by Commissioner McConnell. On roll call the vote was as follows: Yeas: Dierking, Flood, Smith, Landreth and McConnell. Nays: None. Whereupon the Chairman declared the resolution adopted.
