Emerald Cut Diamonds

A rough diamond of 100% will produce 60% finished weight when emerald cut, the brilliant (round) will finish 51%, and the Marquise will produce 36% finished weight. In other words the amount polished away is included in the cost of the diamond and emerald cut loses less of its original weight in cutting. Beyond 1 1/2 carats all three styles cost approximately the same per carat—quality being the same.
