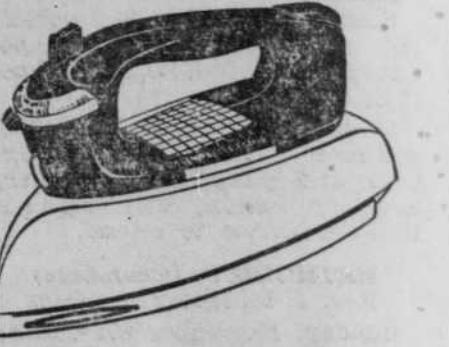
### Spiecker-Harrington Nuptial Rites Here
