## Unevenness Noted in Fat Cattle Trade

Most livestock sold steady to moderately higher Monday at Omaha, though there was some unevenness in fat cattle trade. Bulk of fat cattle were steady, a few select yearlings firm, scattered lots on the late rounds weak to 25c off. Numerous steers and yearlings were bracketed at \$18.50-\$21.25, with better steers in the 11's to 22.40 and 22.50, some weighing 1399 at 21.75, some 1502's \$20.75, and 1580's at \$18.75. Fed heifers bulked at \$16-\$19.50, with better ones 20-\$20.75. Plain killer cattle sold down to \$14, odd head under that.

Cows sold steady to 25c higher, most canners and cutters \$8-\$9, beef cows to \$11. Bologna bulls sold to \$13.75; veal calves to \$19.

Stocker and feeder supply dropped under 4,000, due in part to storms and snow in the West; trade on replacement cattle and calves was firm to 25c and more higher, stock and feeder steers \$16-\$19.75, replacement heifers

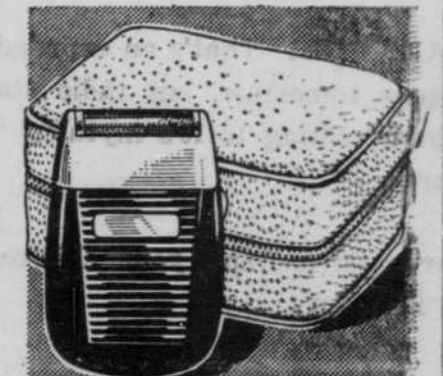
