That the said Orlow Colwell in his lifetime never executed or delivered to the petitioners a deed of conveyance to said real estate, pursuant to the terms of said contract. Petitioners pray that a day be fixed for hearing on said petition, and that notice thereof be given as provided by law, and that upon said hearing a decree be entered directing the Administrator of the Estate of Orlow Colwell, Deceased, for and on behalf of said estate, to execute and deliver good and sufficient deed conveying said premises to petitioners, upon payment by petitioners of the balance due under said contract, and interest.
