I, Kenneth Waring, County Clerk of Holt County, hereby certify that on the 31st day of March 1961, the following Resolution was adopted by the County Board of Holt County in regular meeting assembled.  
Resolved that District No. 7, Holt County enter in a County Lease Agreement with Construction Service Equipment Company, a Nebraska Corporation, Omaha Nebraska for a period commencing on the 24th day of March 1961, and ending on the 30th day of June 1961, upon the terms and conditions contained in a proposed draft submitted and considered by the members at said meeting, and I further certify that the within County Lease Agreement was executed by the County Board at the County Court House of Holt County, on the following equipment:
