The small house of the Jungbluth's was moved Friday, November 10, to the Weber place, 2 1/2 miles west and four miles north of Chambers.

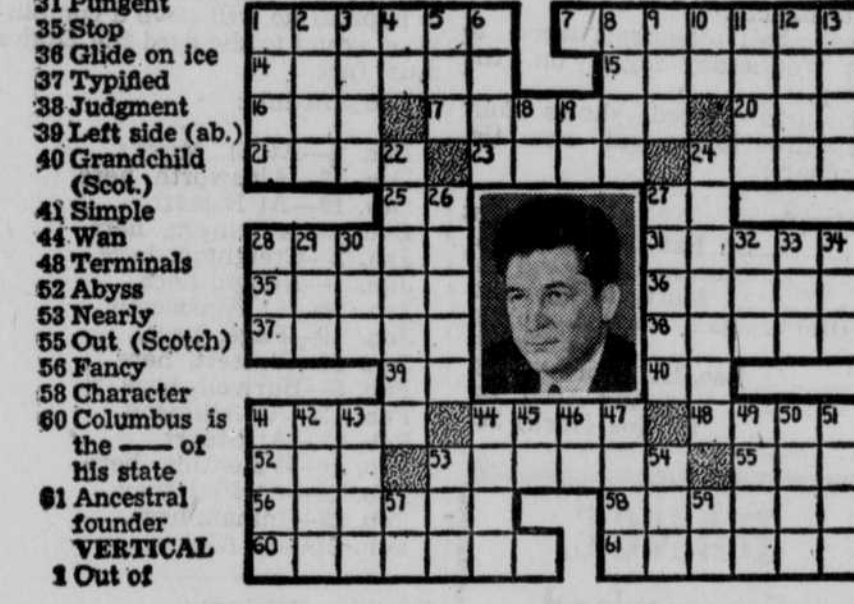
