BAND MUSIC !

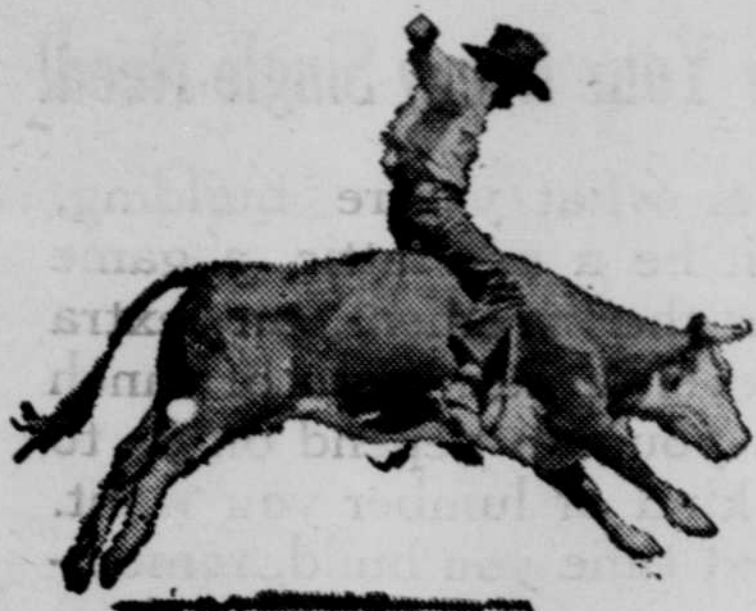
