Lot 2A—

Livestock Showman Contest

Any member showing either Dairy or Beef animals is eligible to enter this contest regardless of placing. Judging will be done on the basis of ability to fit and show the animal. Blue, \$3.00; Red, \$2.00; White, \$1.00.

All members showing will be judged for showmanship while they are showing their livestock. Finals will be run last to determine winners.

Showmanship contest will be set up in Swine and Sheep Divisions if show warrants. Blue \$1.50; Red, \$1.00; White, .75.

Tractor Driving Contest

For 4-H members. Judged on proper handling of tractor, safety precautions and maintenance. \$3.00, \$2.00, \$1.00. Entries are limited to not more than one representative and one alternate from a club. Contest to be at 4 p.m. Thursday.

Livestock Judging

All livestock will be judged and placed according to the Danish system, which is blue ribbon,

red ribbon and white ribbon groups. In addition a purple ribbon group will be selected from the blue awards in each class if the judge feels the show warrants. No purple awards may receive over \$5.00 and a maximum of \$15.00 is set up for a purple ribbon group. This system will carry through in all 4-H livestock classes.

Lot 3—CATTLE

Only two calves can be shown in any market class by a club member. Any club member having more will have to choose the calves to be exhibited. Hay and space will be furnished free for the calves owned by club members that are not to be exhibited. Only the calves originally eartagged may be shown.

4-H bull calves will be shown only in the bull class; 4-H bull calves are not eligible to compete for purple group feeder calves.

No bulls are to be shown unless they are purebred and accompanied by registration papers or proof of eligibility to register in their respective associations. All calves will be shown in the

breeding class for which they were eartagged. or eligible for registry in their respective breed associations.

Breeding Classes

Heifers and bulls shown in these classes must be registered from the Secretary.
