County Champs May Show at Lincoln

Nearly 3,000 rural Nebraska youths are expected to be on hand for the only 4-H show, statewide in scope, at the 1951 Nebraska state fair, September 2-7, according to Wesley M. Antes, of Lincoln, superintendent of class R, boys' and girls' club work.

"The large and complete 4-H program is always one of the Nebraska state fair's biggest attractions," says Ed Schultz, who as secretary of the fair board has directed the fair for nearly a decade.

The eager young competitors will demonstrate their skill in livestock care, food preparation, canning, room arrangement and decoration, home economics, music, and farm safety precautions, as well as in a host of other related fields. Three full days will be devoted to demonstration contests in each of these four divisions — agriculture, homemaking, clothing and foods.

Already boys and girls all over the state are preparing their state fair entries. Careful preparations are needed, too, since competition is extremely stiff at the Cornhusker showplace come September.
