NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that a special election to be held on the 8th day of June, 1960, shall be submitted to the legal voters of School Districts numbered 137, 202, 65, 135, 212, 156, 107, 163, 120, 71, 134, of Holt County, Nebraska, the following question: "Shall the present territories comprising School Districts numbered 137, 202, 65, 135, 212, 156, 107, 163, 120, 71, 134, of the County of Holt, and State of Nebraska, be reorganized and consolidated to comprise and constitute one school district, to be known as School District No. 137, of said County, according to a proposed plan of reorganization of school districts, as formulated and advanced by the Holt County Committee for the Reorganization of School Districts?"

The polls for voting at said election will remain open from 8 o'clock A.M. to 8 o'clock P.M. of said day, and the voting place as follows: Town Hall, Chambers, Nebraska.
Voters desiring to vote in favor of said reorganization plan, will mark an X in the square following the words, "For said reorganization plan."
Voters desiring to vote against said proposition, will mark an X in the square following the words, "Against said reorganization plan."
This special election has been called for the purpose of adopting the electors of School District numbered 137, 202, 65, 135, 212, 156, 107, 163, 120, 71, 134 an opportunity to approve or reject the plan of Organization, adopted by the Holt County Committee for the reorganization of School Districts, under which plan it is proposed to consolidate all of the above mentioned school districts into one school district, to be known as School District No. 137 of Holt County, Nebraska.
That said proposed plan of reorganization contemplates that said reorganized and consolidated District, shall have the legal outer boundaries, described as follows:
1. Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section 31, Township 25, Range 13, West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County, Nebraska, running thence two miles east, thence 3 miles north, thence two miles east, thence 2 miles north, thence 2 miles east, thence 1/2 mile east, thence 1/2 mile south, thence 1/2 mile west, thence one mile south, thence 5/2 miles east, thence 1/2 mile north, thence 3 1/2 miles east, thence 2 1/2 miles north, thence 3 miles east, thence 1 mile north, thence 3 miles west, thence 4 miles north, Northeast corner of Section 15, Township 27, Range 11 West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County, Nebraska, running thence 7 miles west, thence 1/2 mile north, thence 1/2 mile east, thence 1 mile north, thence 1 1/2 miles west, thence 1 1/2 miles south, thence two miles west, thence 1 1/2 miles east, thence 6 miles west, thence 1 1/2 miles east, thence 1 mile west, thence 1 mile south, thence one mile west, thence 2 miles south, thence one mile east, thence one mile south, beginning.
2. Reasons for the change in boundaries is to provide more adequate educational advantages for the children in the ten Class I Districts and the Class II Districts.
3. The plan of reorganization proposes the adjustment of property debts, and liabilities of the proposed District as follows:
a. All of the assets and property of the districts included in this plan as of July 1, 1960, shall become the property of the proposed School District No. 137.
b. All of the bonded indebtedness existing against any of said districts is to be assumed and paid by the original District No. 137, that is District No. 137 as it existed prior to such reorganization and consolidation.
c. All other School Districts debts, if any, of said Districts, as of July 1, 1960, are to be assumed and paid by the proposed School District No. 137.
d. The utilization of existing school houses and school property is to be determined by the legal voters of the proposed School District No. 137, in the event such reorganization becomes effective, however this shall pertain to school houses and school grounds only.
4. The present school building of District No. 137 will not be adequate but additional class rooms can be built as a second floor over the present gym.
Legal school electors only residing within the enumerated districts shall be permitted to vote at said election, and the legal electors residing in School District No. 137, shall be entitled to vote as a separate unit at said election.
Any electors or other interested persons, may secure additional information concerning the details of said proposed plan of reorganization at the Office of the County Superintendent of Schools in O'Neill, Nebraska.
