AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF O'NEILL, NEBRASKA, AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 355A OF SAID CITY, WHICH CREATED SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 1, BY INCREASING THE ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE PROPOSED SEWER SYSTEM EXTENSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF O'NEILL, NEBRASKA:
Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 355A of the City of O'Neill, Nebraska, is hereby amended to read as follows:
"Section 5. The Engineer's estimate of the total cost of the proposed extension of the City's sanitary sewer system is \$21,000.00."
