## Feast On Holiday Mushroom Muffins





HOLIDAY MUFFINS 1 can (114 cups) condensed cream of mushroom soup 1/2 cup chopped walnuts 1/4 cup melted shortening 1 egg, beaten

\* Sift dry ingredients into a bowl. Mix soup, walnuts, shortening and egg; add to flour mixture. Stir until well blended. Fill greased muffin tins 3/3 full. Bake in a hot oven (400° F.) about 20 minutes. Makes 12 muffins.
