

Ottawa Carillon is an Unique Attraction

THE targest of the 53 bells in the carillon of the Peac Tower of the Parliament Buildings at Ottawa weighs 22,400 pounds and is pitched to "E." The smallest of the bells, weighing 10 pounds, is pitched to "A", four and onehalf octaves above.

Across the Parliament grounds from the famed Chateau Laurier, the carillon, originally installed in 1927, is one of the great tourist attractions of Canada's capital city.

Robert Donnell, Dominion Carilloneur since 1939, has made more than 2,000 arrangements for the bells, as well as composing. Since carillons differ in the number of balls, all music must be especially arranged. Playing the carillon is a feat of strength as well as skill. The keyboard is six feet long and consists of peg-like keys forced down by the fist, and foot pedals are used for sounding the bass. Expression is given to the music through the variation of touch, and guards must be worn to protect the carilloneur's
