**Burglars' Effort
Futile at School
Man Found Asleep
in Weeds Quizzed**

Holt county authorities are still probing a break-in at the O'Neill public school which took place early Friday morning. Custodian Harry Graham and Junior Mace discovered the break-in when they reported for work. The intruders gained entrance through a window in the hallway that links the main building and the gymnasium. They removed the glass from the door leading into the superintendent's office and went to the vocational agriculture room and borrowed a bolt cutter with which to snap the bars in a steel gate. The gate is used to seal off the corridor between the main building and the auditorium. Holt Sheriff Leo Tomjack said Wednesday no items have yet been reported missing. "The burglars knew their way around the building, all right," he declared, "and a large piece of iron was found—presumably for use in forcing entry."

**Petersburg Youth
Dies of Injuries**

CLEARWATER—Donald Majerus, 21, of Petersburg died in a Neleigh hospital Tuesday of injuries suffered in an auto accident one-half mile east of Clearwater on U. S. highway 275 early Monday.

Sheriff Lawrence Ritteher said Majerus was a passenger in a car driven by Richard F. Brachle, 17, of Albion. He said Brachle lost control and the car hit a bridge rail, rode up the rail and then plunged into a creek.

A chunk of angle iron which had penetrated Majerus' thigh had to be cut with a torch before he could be removed to a hospital.
