8. Angus heifers — Blue, Red, White

Club Group of Three Beef

20. Any club may select three animals to show as a group. All three must belong in the same class, such as baby beef stocker-feeder, etc. Stocker-feeder club group to be judged separate.

4-H Dairy Cattle

Each breed will have all divisions. Awards will be the same for each division. A purple award group within dairy will be selected if show warrants.

21. Jr. calves (born Jan. 1, 1957, to Feb. 28, 1957).
22. Senior calves (born July 1, 1956 to Dec. 31, 1956).
23. Junior yearlings (born Jan. 1, 1956 to June 30, 1956).
24. Senior yearlings (born July 1, 1955, to Dec. 31, 1955).
25. 2-year-olds (born July 1, 1954, to June 30, 1955).
26. Cows over 2-years-old. (All cows born prior to July 1, 1954).

Senior yearlings that have been freshened on or before the day of the show must show in class for 2-year-olds.

27. Jr. herd of 3 (cows, heifer and calf of same breed). Blue, \$5; Red, \$4; White, \$3.

Club Groups of Three

28. Club group of three dairy animals. Any club may select 3 animals from one class and show as a group.

LOT 5 — HOGS

Four - H members carrying market hogs or sow and litter projects are eligible to show in this lot. An animal can be shown only in one class in 4-H division

29. Market hog — fat barrow or gilt, all breeds competing together. Blue, \$3; Red, \$2; White, \$1; all others, 50c.
30. Market litter—6 or more gilts and barrows. All breeds competing together. Blue, \$10; Red, \$7.50; White, \$5; and all others, \$1.

31. Purebred litter — 6 or more boars and gilts. Blue, \$10; Red, \$7.50; White, \$5; all others \$1.

32. Purebred gilt born after January 1, 1957. Blue, \$3; Red, \$2; White, \$1; all others, \$1.
33. Purebred boar born after January 1, 1957. Blue, \$3; Red, \$2; White, \$1; all others, 50c.

All classes of breeding hogs to be shown by breeds with purple

awards if show warrants.

LOT 6 — SHEEP

Only 4-H club members carrying sheep projects may compete.

34. Fat lambs Blue, Red, White
35. Breeding ewe lambs — Blue, Red, White
36. Breeding buck lambs — Blue, Red, White

Blue, \$3; Red, \$2; White, \$1. All

others, 50c. Purple award if show warrants.

LOT 7 — SADDLE STOCK

37. Yearling colts, 1-year and under.

38. One to 2-years of age. Blue, \$5; Red, \$4; White, \$3.

39. Over 2-years of age. All others, \$-. Purple award if show warrants.
