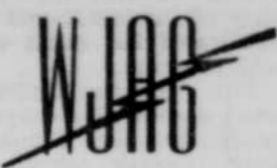

Record White-Tail Killed in Deer Hunt

MacLachlan Rites Today at Atkinson

Spend Many Years Farming in Holt

Nebraska's deer season opened Friday and 8,500 hunters took to the fields.

In the upper Missouri river area (including Holt, Boyd and Knox counties), prey was not as plentiful as in western Nebraska. Most deer in this region were taken in north Holt.

Cletus Durr of Stuart killed a huge white-tail at the George Shald ranch, north of Stuart. The animal hog-dressed at 249 1/2 pounds. Previous record for a white-tail in Nebraska was a dressed weight of 235 pounds, established a year ago in Keith county. Whether any hunters this season bagged a larger one than Durr's has not yet been established.

Last year Durr and a companion sighted this same deer and the Stuart man vowed he'd 'get it' when the next season rolled around if he was lucky enough to get a permit.

Carl Habel of Ewing shot and killed a deer with a bow and arrow.

Habel got his deer about 30 miles southeast of O'Neill. It was a 150-pound mule which he killed with a 60-pound Kodiak bow and arrow.

Four members of one O'Neill household received permits—Mr. and Mrs. Clarence Booth and daughter, Joanne, and Mr. Booth's

ATKINSON—Robert MacLachlan, 74, died about 4 p.m., Monday, November 4, at Atkinson Memorial hospital.

Services Held Monday for Prominent Well-Driller - Plumber

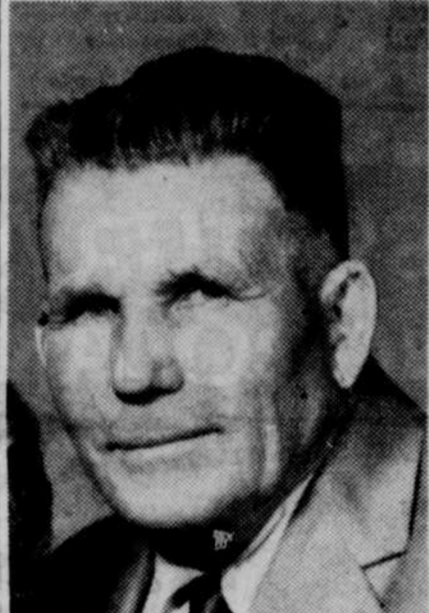

Blacks Wed 60 Years; Affair Held

John D. Pruss, Retired Holt Farmer, Expires

John D. Pruss, 72, virtually a lifelong resident of Holt county, died at St. Anthony's hospital Friday, November 1. A retired farmer, he had been ill about 2 1/2 years.

Funeral services were held at 9:30 a.m., Monday, November 4, at St. Patrick's Catholic church with Very Rev. Timothy O'Sullivan officiating. Burial was in Calvary cemetery under the direction of Biglin's.

The body lay in state at Biglin's funeral chapel Sunday from 2:30 to 5:30 p.m. and at 7:30 p.m. The Catholic Daughters held a rosary at 4 p.m., Sunday and a parish rosary was said at 7:45 p.m., followed by a rosary conducted by the Knights of Columbus.

He was united in marriage to Mary Florence Foreman on June 24, 1908 at St. Patrick's church in O'Neill. After living a year in Emmet, they settled on a farm north of Emmet, where their three children were born. When his health failed, he retired and moved to O'Neill in October, 1956, where he lived at the time of his death.

Mr. Pruss was a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Holy Name Society. He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Mrs. John (Jessie) Martfield.
