



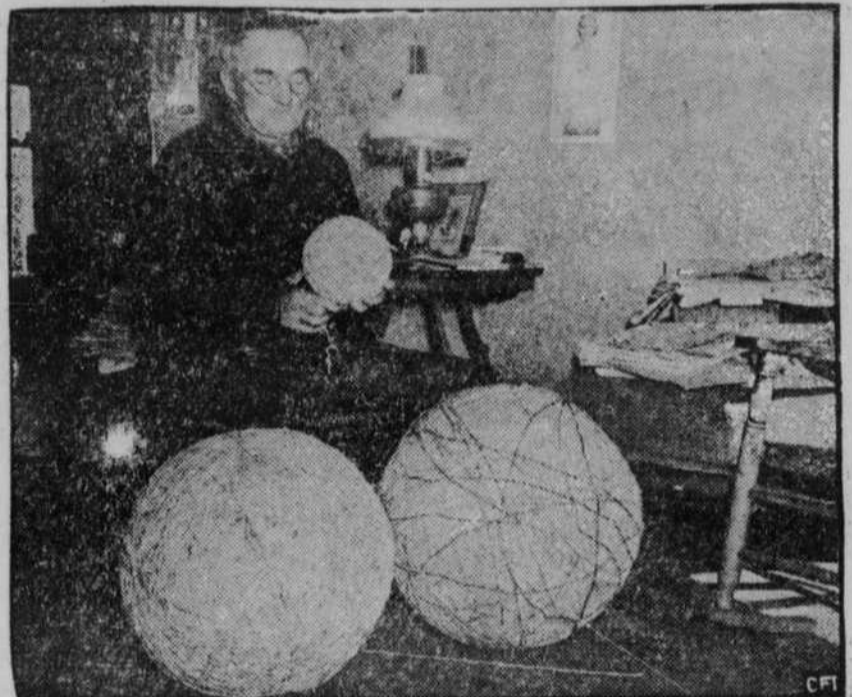
**SEARCHING FOR SURVIVORS OF AIRLINER**

**Chicken Mousse**  
1 four pound chicken.  
5 eggs  
1-2 teaspoon Baking powder  
2 tablespoons flour  
1 can mushrooms  
2 cups bread crumbs (have bread a day old)  
2 1-2 cups milk  
2 tablespoons butter  
1 pint thin cream  
Direction:  
Put the breast and upper joint of chicken through meat grinder. Cut crust from the bread and soak bread in the milk. Yolks of two eggs and half teaspoon baking powder. In this mixture, add the ground chicken. Salt and pepper to taste. Let stand an hour. Just before using, whip the whites of four eggs and fold in. Have well greased mould and fill with chicken mixture. Set mould in pan of water. Bake about forty minutes, or until firm.  
Sauce: Cook all remaining chicken until tender. When done, cut chicken in small pieces. Make cream sauce of the butter, flour and cream. Add chicken and mushrooms to this sauce. When mousse is done turn out on dish and fill with sauce.  
NOTE: As soon as breast and forelegs are off the chicken, put remaining chicken on to cook at once.

Juice of 1 lemon  
Grated rind of lemon  
1 t. baking powder  
Cream butter and sugar together. Add beaten egg yolks. Stir well, lemon juice, grated rind and baking powder. Add to Zwiebach and to egg mixture, then add ground almonds. Mix all well. Add beaten egg whites and add 2 cups of pitted red sweet cherries. (Cherries should be drained for 2 hours). Bake in spring form in slow oven about 1 hour. Serve with whipped cream.

**Rum Cake**  
Whites of 8 eggs beaten stiff  
Add 1-2 teaspoon cream of tartar  
1 1-2 cups sugar, and add yolks of 4 eggs well beaten. Fold in 1 cup pastry flour, sifted three times. Bake in large tin and split in two or bake in 2 layers.

**Filling**  
4 egg yolks well beaten. 1 3-4 cups milk, 3-4 cup sugar. Cook like custard and add 2 tablespoons plain gelatin dissolved in a little cold water. Let cool. Then add 1-2 pint cream whipped and flavored with rum. Let custard get thick, but not stiff, then beat in whipped cream. Put between layers and chick on top. Put in ice box at once to set.

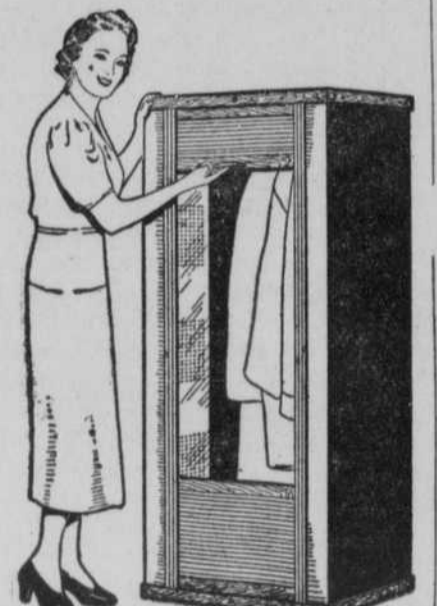
