R. D. McGee, 25 year-old Negro, was hanged to a tree and his body was pierced with bullets about 9 a. m., for an alleged attack on the 11-year old daughter of a white dairy farmer. An unidentified Negro was whipped and released by a crowd of white men because of an alleged insult to a white woman.

Physicians said that the girl was not criminally attacked but that she had been choked into unconsciousness.
