Billy Costum is a rather superman now since—the chic that he picked was strictly from KC. Martha Lee Please!

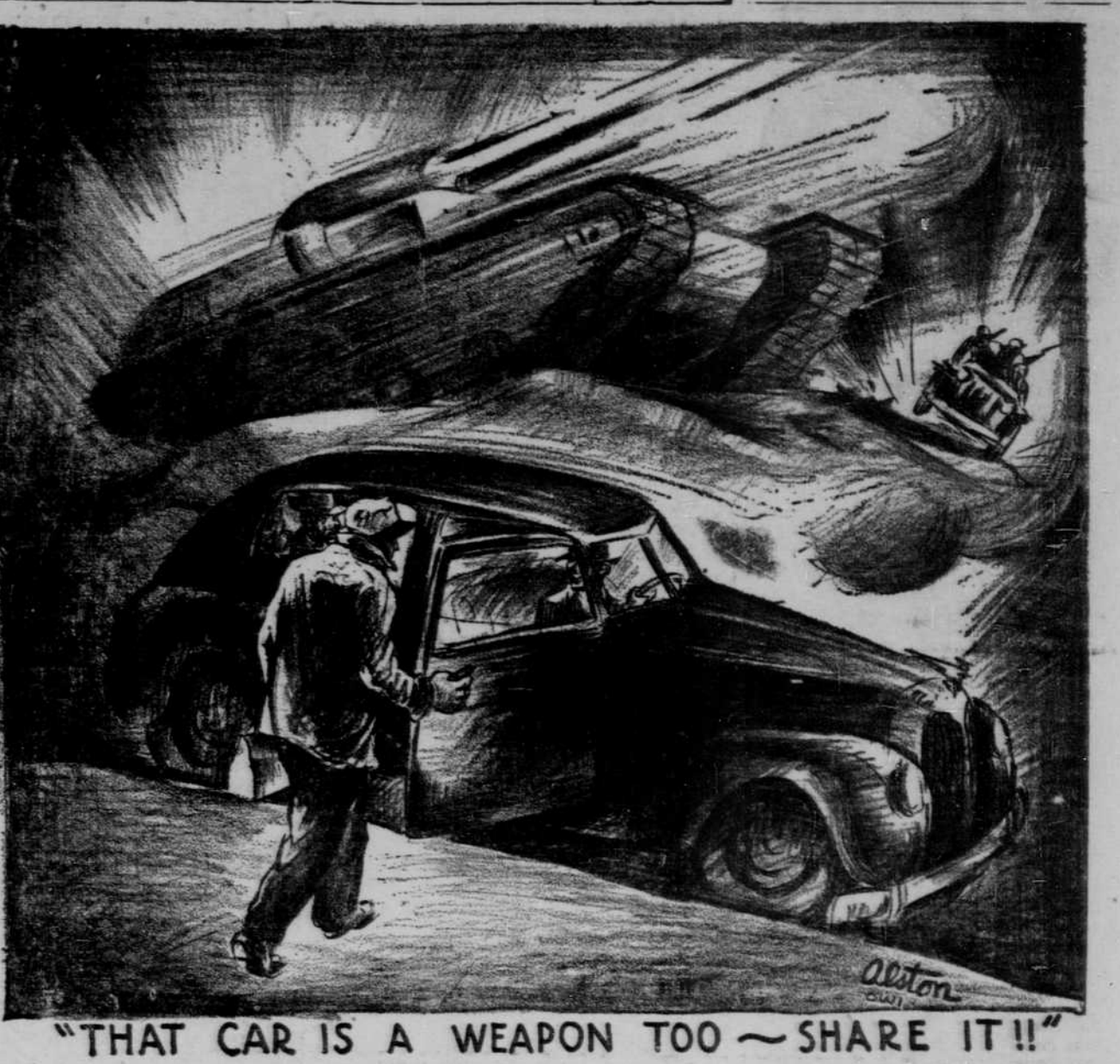

(Continued from page 1) less than one fifteenth per child of what is spent on an average per child throughout the nation. Yet no genuine democracy can exist or long survive without proper education. A bill to provide federal aid to education, with no strings attached to the federal subsidy except that there should be no racial or religious discrimination in the expenditure of the funds, was introduced in the last Congress but died there. Mr. Roosevelt as a true democratic leader should have supported the bill but did not.

"Finally, as Commander-in-Chief of the Army and Navy, our President should have spoken out against the frequent indignities and occasional brutalities to which Negro soldiers are subjected especially in the training camps in the South. Yet here again he was disappointingly silent."
