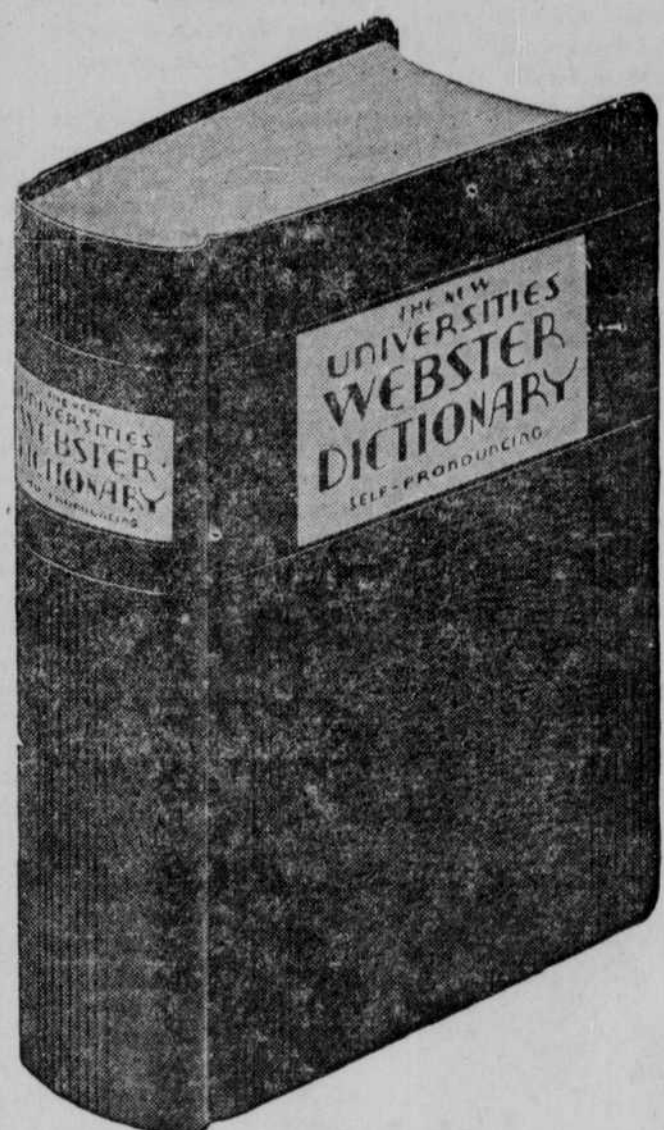
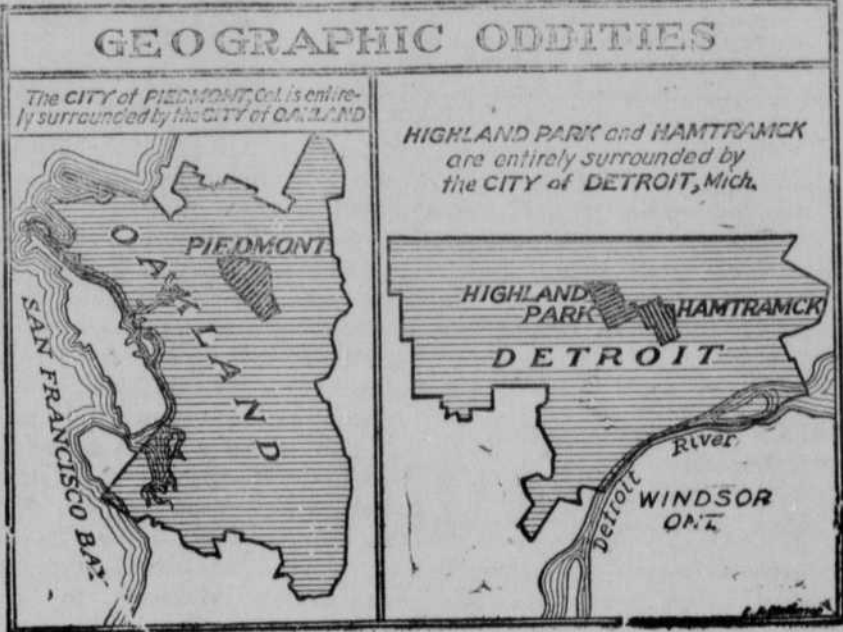


DANZIG AND MEMEL

The Free City of DANZIG, on the Baltic Sea, between the "Polish Corridor" and East Prussia seems destined to assume a historic significance that is out of all proportion to its real importance. As the major "casus belli" of the present European conflict, Danzig has held the spotlight in the "war of nerves" for months past. For the present, of course, it is a part of the German Reich, but what its ultimate political fate will be depends entirely on the outcome of the real war that now rages so relentlessly in central Europe.

Naturally the long-continued publicity that has kept Danzig so much in the public eye has had its effect among philatelists. For months past there has been a steadily-growing demand for the stamps of Danzig and now that they are no longer being surcharged stamps of Danzig have been issued to increase still more. The territory which issues, of course, always have

been relatively plentiful, especially those of the post-war inflation period. MEMEL, another former German city on the Baltic Sea, has had a somewhat similar history. After the World War this city, together with a strip of territory adjoining it to the southeast, was placed under international control for a time, but, subsequently, was absorbed by Lithuania. Last spring it became the object of another of Hitler's spectacular land grabs, and since then has been a part of the German Reich. The philatelic history of Memel was relatively short. For three years or so the city used overprinted stamps of France. Then, following its occupation by Lithuania, there came an issue of overprinted Lithuanian stamps. In 1923 there appeared an issue commemorating the union of Memel with Lithuania, followed by an issue of surcharged stamps. After that the issued the prices of recent issues seem to have been fixed to increase still more. The territory which issues, of course, always have
